- U6-U9 development was remarkably successful with great attendance from the players and coaches. U11-U15 divisions were also very well attended with coaches and players.



Player Development

- Additional development initiatives were implemented this season with the following: U11, U13, U15 C Prospect Development.
- These sessions were designed for our players in these divisions that had the desire for extra development.
- These sessions were run in cooperation with the Pacific Titans and our A1 coaches.
- The sessions ran 6 weeks prior to Christmas and 6 weeks after Christmas.
- They were exceedingly popular.



Player Development

- The rep sessions were run with each team receiving five sessions with our player development provider.
- These sessions were coordinated, and session themes were planned out in advance of the sessions in collaboration with the coaches which provided the teams with great development sessions.
- We have increased the Goalie and player development for A2-A4 teams from 5 sessions to 8 sessions for the coming season to increase the development of our players.
